In Geography we will learn about where we live.



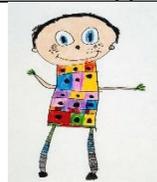
Where do I live?

In Art we will be learning how to use different materials to create our own pieces of work.



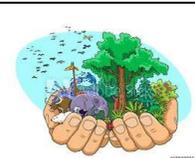
What do I look like?
